Agriculture and Livelihoods

- 116,365 farmers trained in conservation agriculture and livestock management;
- 19,463 farmers trained in horticulture crop production;
- 46 sand abstraction systems rehabilitated;
- 19 irrigation schemes developed/rehabilitated;
- 556 farmers performed agricultural activities in developed/rehabilitated irrigation schemes;
- 9,791 farmers adopted improved small grain seeds;
- 213 agricultural input fairs facilitated;
- 56 agrodealers and 24 input suppliers participated in input fairs;
- 46 dip tanks constructed/rehabilitated benefiting 69,960 livestock;
- 48 dams constructed/rehabilitated benefiting 52,769 livestock;

Resilience

- 905 village saving and lending (VS&L) groups formed and strengthened;
- **8,407** individuals participated in VS&L;

- 15,431 community members participated in cash for assets work;
- 2,537 hectares of grazing land rehabilitated under cash/food for assets;
- **65** ward disaster risk reduction committees strengthened;

Health and Nutrition

- 27 health centers with rehabilitated water and sanitation facilities;
- 62,260 individuals trained on Healthy Harvest (promotion of a healthy nutritious plate);
- 55,317 individuals participated in cooking classes promoting nutritious locally available foods;
- 84,777 pregnant women received monthly rations of nutritious supplementary feeding;
